Service Animals, Emotional Support Animals, and Therapy Animals



Service Animal (ADA) - A dog (or a miniature horse) that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities.

Emotional Support Animal - A **pet** that provides therapeutic support to a person with a diagnosed mental health problem.

Therapy Animal - Part of an animal-handler team (pet) that has been trained and evaluated to visit/work with clients who enjoy animals.
